SERMON RECAP - July 2026

Sermon 1: Your Passion Can't Outrun Your Patterns

Main Passage: Luke 6:46-49

Takeaway: Passion may inspire you, but patterns form you.

A life built on Jesus is formed through daily obedience, surrender, and putting His words into practice.

Question: What pattern needs to break, and what new pattern do you need to build to become who Jesus is calling you to be?

Sermon 2: When Jesus Sends You

Main Passage: Matthew 10:1-25

Takeaway: Jesus doesn't call you because you have it all together. He chooses you on purpose, equips you with what you need, and sends you to faithfully obey.

Question: Where is Jesus asking you to stop waiting until you feel ready and simply trust Him enough to go?

Sermon 3: Not Afraid to Speak His Name

Main Passage: Matthew 10:26-33

Takeaway: Courage doesn't come from becoming fearless, it comes from knowing who you belong to. When Jesus is the loudest voice in your life, fear no longer gets the final say.

Question: Where has fear caused you to hide your faith, and what would it look like to boldly acknowledge Jesus in that place?

Sermon 4: The Cost of Peace

Main Passage: Matthew 10:23-42

Takeaway: The peace Jesus brings isn't the absence of conflict, it's a life fully surrendered to Him. Following Jesus means putting Him first, taking up your cross, and pouring your life out for what matters eternally.

Question: What comfort, relationship, or priority is competing with Jesus for the throne of your life?
